1. THE HEALTHCARE FACILITY AND THE U.S.I. GROUP

The U.S.I. (International Health Union) S.p.A. was founded in 1953 by Dr. Luigi Sperone becoming, over the years, an integrated health network consisting of more than thirty facilities and over five hundred specialized operators.

The most widespread healthcare reality in Rome, since 2022 the U.S.I. has also been present in the Tuscany Region.

The headquarters of U.S.I. Piazza Vittorio, located in via Machiavelli 22 in the Esquilino district, a few steps from Termini Station and Piazza Vittorio, is extended over 5 levels and provides the following health services, subsequently deepened:

- **Clinical Laboratory Analysis** (Blood samples)
- **Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation** (floor I)
- **Specialist Medicine and Instrumental Diagnostics** (floors II and III)
- **Surgical Outpatient Clinic** (floor III)
- **Diagnostic Imaging** (Traditional Radiology: floor -I; Magnetic Resonance Imaging and CT scan: ground floor)

The facility is accredited with the Health Service of the Lazio Region (the regional accreditation resolutions are shown at the bottom of the front page of this service charter). Countless services are provided in agreement with the NHS or with private bodies, as detailed in the following chapters.

The structures of the U.S.I. provide an integrated, wide and advanced healthcare offer in the field of Clinical Laboratory Analyses (*Clinical Chemistry, Molecular Biology, Cyto-Histopathology*), Diagnostic Imaging and Nuclear Medicine (*Magnetic Resonance, CT, Digital Radiodiagnostics, Ultrasound, PET, Scintigraphy*), Specialist Medicine and Occupational Medicine, Cancer Prevention and Treatment (*Radiation Oncology*).

2. QUALITY, CLINICAL RISK MANAGEMENT, SUSTAINABILITY

Since its founding U.S.I. applies advanced quality control and management systems that provide for participation in national and international programs. All services are provided in compliance with guidelines and methods recognized by the scientific community. Clinical risk is assessed at all stages of the health pathway.

The *vision* and *mission* of the U.S.I. can be summarized in a wide range of healthcare offer, of high quality standard, accessible and widespread in the territory, based on highly qualified personnel, advanced technologies and management models oriented towards Quality, Safety, Effectiveness, protection of users' rights and economic, environmental and social sustainability.

The *vision* and *mission* of the U.S.I. can be summarized in a wide healthcare offer, of high quality standards, accessible and widespread in the territory, based on highly qualified personnel, advanced technologies and management models oriented towards Quality, Safety, Effectiveness, protection of users' rights and economic, environmental and social sustainability.

The processes are constantly monitored using indicators relating to the quality of performance, analytical accuracy, waiting times, rates of repetitions and cancellations of services, satisfaction of users and interested parties, incidence of any "non-conformities", complaints, accidents, adverse events and the effectiveness of the improvement actions undertaken.

The structure's Quality System is certified according to the international standard UNI EN ISO 9001:2015 issued by a prestigious certification body.

The health facility is also accredited with the Health Service of the Lazio Region, based on *the Additional requirements for the accreditation of health facilities*, governed by the reference legislation.

3. INFORMED CONSENT, RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PATIENT

The healthcare facility actively guarantees the right of patients and users:

- ✓ to be informed in an appropriate and understandable way about their state of health and characteristics, risks and alternatives to the services that concern them, expressing their consent or refusal in advance;
- ✓ to be assisted with care, impartiality, confidentiality and confidentiality, respecting their time, dignity, philosophical or religious needs and convictions;
- ✓ the transparency and simplicity of administrative paths;
- ✓ to the Safety and Quality of health services;
- ✓ to the complaint and to an appropriate response.

Please note that it is always advisable to:

- ✓ prospect to the staff any needs related to their health conditions, to prevent any risks (e.g. in the event of problems related to patient mobility or therapies already in progress);
- ✓ a behavior based on respect and understanding of the rights of other users and patients, as well as trust and collaboration with healthcare personnel;
- ✓ compliance with the schedules of the booked services, informing in the event of delays or cancellations.

4. USER PROTECTION, SUGGESTIONS AND COMPLAINTS

Suggestions or complaints can be made through the [www.usi.it website](http://www.usi.it), on "white paper" or on the *Satisfaction Questionnaire* available in the acceptance secretariat and once completed to be inserted in the appropriate containers or to be sent by ordinary mail or e-mail to the addresses indicated in this Service Charter.

Complaints and suggestions are analysed by the Health or Laboratory Technical Management and the departments involved and a response is ensured in the shortest possible time, in any case no later than 30 days, except for important obstructive causes.

5. ACCESS TO BENEFITS AND COSTS

Services in agreement with the NHS

To access services provided under the National Health Service (NHS) agreement, an SSN referral issued by the attending physician is required; this must specify the clinical question and any applicable exemptions. Typically, the referral is valid for 180 days if no priority class is indicated and covers up to eight services per medical specialty.

For services in agreement with the NHS, the same rates are applied as for public facilities.

Services under private regime or in agreement with private entities

A prescription from your doctor or specialist may be required for certain services. Refer to the following chapters of the service charter in relation to the specific services.

Information is provided at the reception secretariats or by contacting the single number **06 32868.1** on the costs of services provided under a private regime or in agreement with private bodies and on any specific or multidisciplinary health packages.

Preparation and other performance information

Information on the times, methods of preparation and characteristics of health services are available at the reception secretariats or by contacting the single number **06 32868.1**.

On **the www.usi.it website**, information notices containing indications for correct preparation and information on the health services provided are also available.

Further information is provided in subsequent chapters of the service charter in relation to the specific services and in *brochures* available at the facility for certain services.

Please note that health information can only be released by the health personnel in charge of the services.

Payment methods

Payment of services is possible by cash and bank cards. For further payment methods, you can request information at the time of booking or by calling the single number **06 32868.1**.

For information on the stipulation of agreements with private organizations, you can contact the relevant office at the e-mail address convenzioni@usi.it.

Preferential access and emergencies

Preferential paths are provided for patients in a condition of fragility (e.g. reduced mobility or affected by oncological or debilitating diseases), also considering the needs related to religious beliefs or cultural aspects.

For any emergencies, the health personnel concerned evaluates the execution of the analyzes in the time required, establishing the time for the release of the complete or partial report in the shortest possible technical time.

Indicate any needs during the acceptance phase or contact the single number **06 32868.1** to agree on the appropriate preferential access methods.

Additional Useful Information

At the structure there is staff able to communicate in **English** and / or in other foreign languages. An English version of the Service Charter is available and can be requested from the Secretariat.

The staff of the health facility, even in the training phase, can be identified by the identification card.

Hand sanitizers are available in the property. Proper hand hygiene easily prevents most healthcare-associated infections (HAIs). Consult the **www.usi.it** website for information campaigns on prevention promoted by the U.S.I.

6. THE COLLECTION OF REPORTS

The collection of the reports and any attachments can be carried out at the Acceptance Secretariat or "*online*", activating the relevant service at the time of acceptance.

Please note that the reports can be delivered, according to the deadlines indicated in chapter 7, only:

- to the person concerned or delegated person (who must present his/her identity document, the proxy and a copy of the identity document of the delegating party);
- in the case of a minor, to the person concerned with an identity document or to the person exercising parental authority, with an identity document;
- to the guardian or curator with an identity document and the necessary documentation.

The storage of health documentation is carried out in accordance with mandatory legislation. For any duplicates of paper reports, consider the ordinary times defined according to the type of report (see chapter 7).

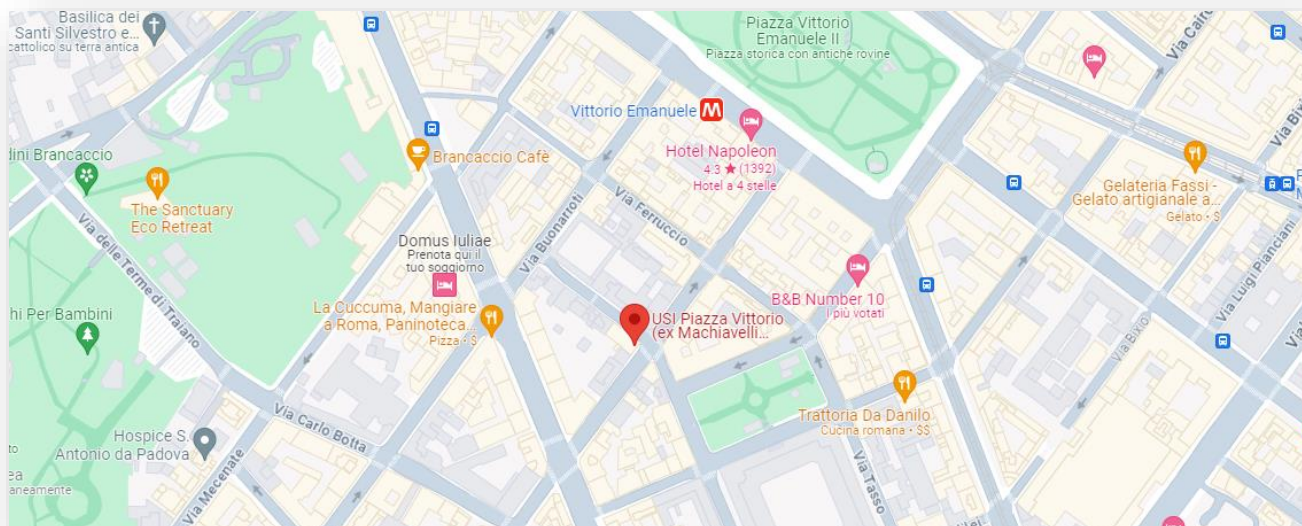
